

Tabletop Cable Organizer

The TT-CMK provides convenient tabletop cable management. The cable organizer routes network, audio, and video connections to a user's laptop for Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) presentation from a room box or room controller mounted under the table.



In the Box

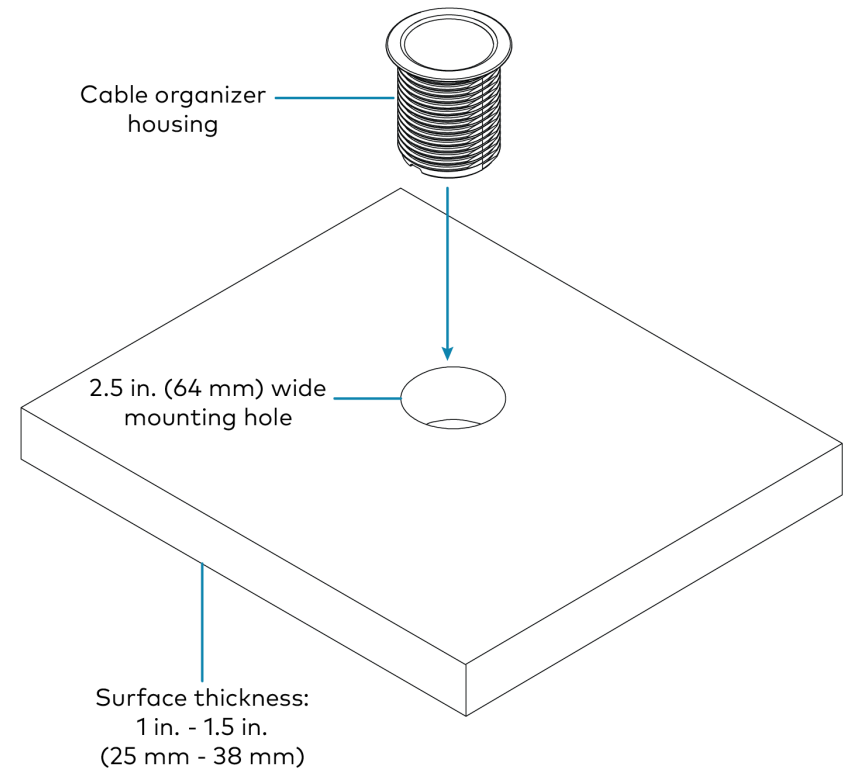
- 1 Cable organizer housing, Plastic, Black (2056826)
- 1 Cable organizer plate, Plastic, Black (2056825)
- 2 Locking nut, Plastic, Black (2056824)
- 2 Screw, 4-40 x 3/8 in., Pan Head, Phillips, Black (2007170)



Install the Cable Organizer

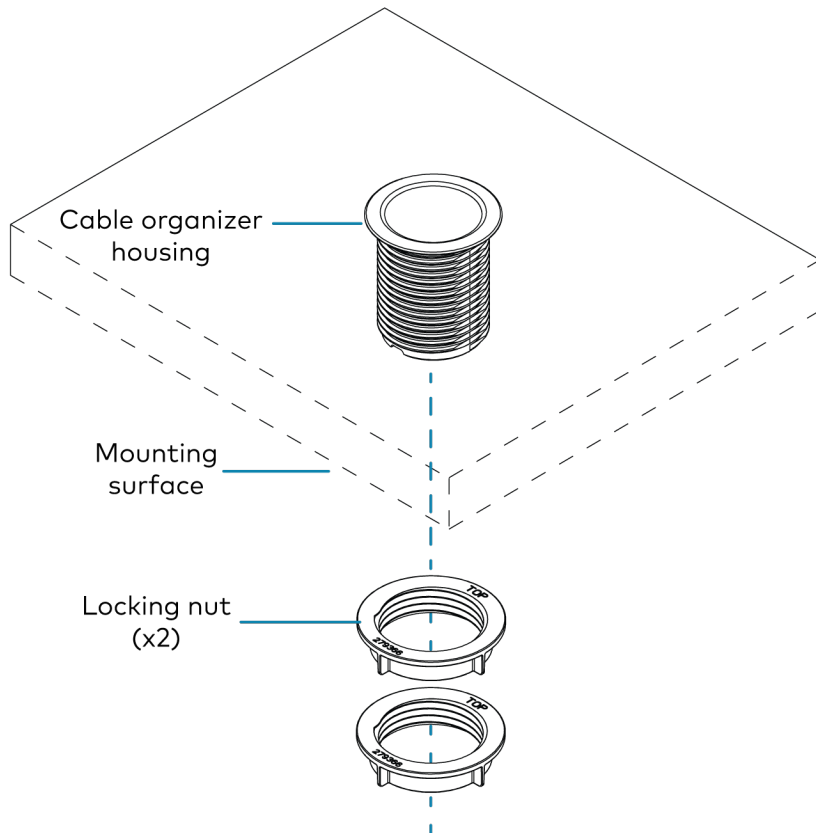
To install the cable organizer:

1. Select a mounting surface with a thickness of 1 in. (25 mm) to 1.5 in. (38 mm).
2. Use a hole saw to cut a 2.5 in. (64 mm) wide mounting hole in the mounting surface.
3. Insert the cable organizer housing into the mounting hole.

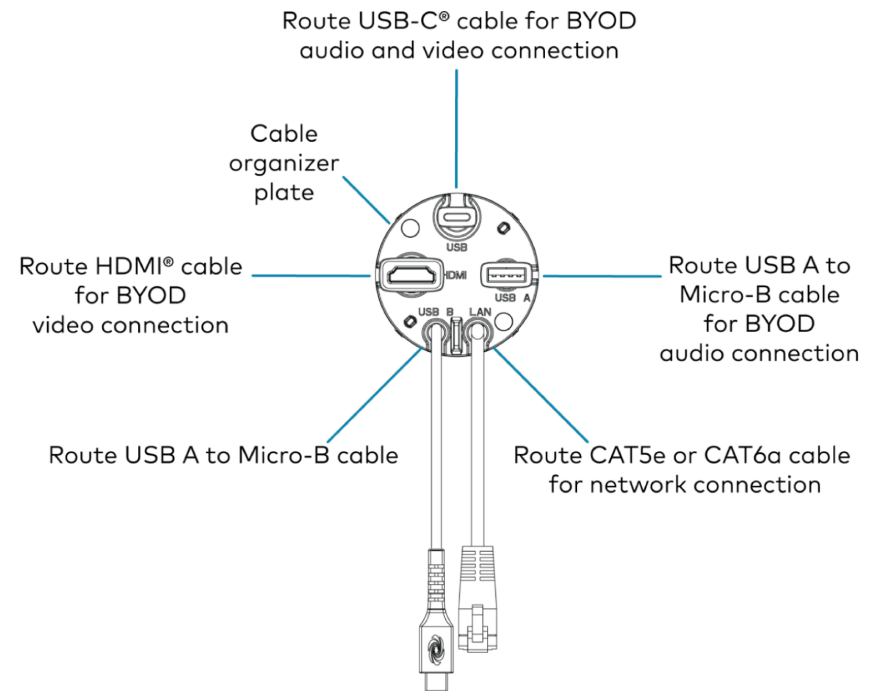


Tabletop Cable Organizer

- Secure the cable organizer housing to the mounting surface using the included locking nuts. Ensure the TOP label on the locking nuts is face up.

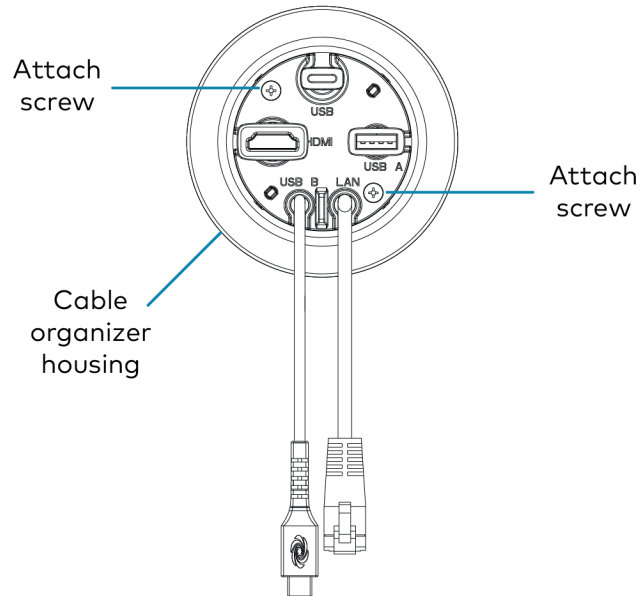


- Pass cables through the bottom of the cable organizer housing to the tabletop.
- Route the cables through the routing holes on the cable organizer plate.

7. Attach the cable organizer plate to the cable organizer housing with the included screws.



8. Above the mounting surface, pull all of the cables out to the needed length. Ensure there is at least 2 in. (51 mm) of cable slack beneath the mounting surface, and attach a cable tie (not included) to each cable. Trim the cable ties as needed and push the cables back to the cable organizer plate.
